iii. Update – ongoing CIP Projects

Ms. Natalie Charette updated the committee on various CIP projects such as:

- The Tapis Ranger property has informed that they were having difficulty securing a contractor but that the project was going to be started prior to October. They also plan to apply for signage for the property.
- Carole from Carole's Boutik is interested in applying to the CIP. There will be further discussions with the property owner to move this project forward.
- The property owner for 23 Kenyon Street East will be applying to the signage program over the next few months.
- The property known as Alexandria Florist is changing hands and staff has spoken with the new property owner to apply to the CIP.
- 88 St-Paul Street, there are still issues with getting the stained glass installed but staff will be following up with the property owner to ensure that they meet the extension timelines.
- 18 Catherine Street in Maxville will be applying in the spring 2021.
- The property owner at 343 Main Street in Alexandria will be applying for the CIP program but in the meantime, staff is working with them to clarify the parameters for the CIP.
- 124 126 Main Street in Alexandria the new owners are looking at obtaining quotes for the CIP to reinstate the items that were removed under the previous owner.
- 33 Main Street South in Maxville the permit has been issued and the project is slowly moving forward.
